

Understand the questions users are struggling with and who may be missing multiple questions across targeted training for quick remediation.






 Next Generation Report Filters: Filter your Training data by specific attributes of participants, key user segments and campaigns

### **Living Security Teams**


• Book a Game for Your Team: Register colleagues for the same event
